Dear Peter:

I have received your January 18 letter (your file A-2011-00104- YMN).

The information you enclose is correct for the organization "Friends of Canadian Broadcasting" but is incorrect with respect to me. I did not receive any remuneration from CBC/Radio Canada in 2001 (as is incorrectly indicated in the enclosure to your letter).

If it is of any assistance to you to confirm the above statement, in and around that year I lived at [REDACTED]. My social insurance number is [REDACTED]. I have never had any affiliation with the Canadian Media Guild nor its parent, the Communications Workers of America. In 2001 I did have my travel and accommodation expenses reimbursed as a speaker on the topic "How Should the CBC be Governed?" at a conference CMG co-sponsored with Carleton University in Ottawa (January 28, 2001). Also, I am aware of the meaning of the phrase "CMG Casual" and can confirm that this Ian Morrison has never, and specifically in 2001 did not receive any remuneration in such a capacity.

I am making available to you this personal information for the exclusive purpose of assisting you to correct the mis-information included in the enclosure to your January 18, 2012 letter and I request that you not allow the above personal information to be used for any other purpose by the Corporation.

Also, please note that your January 18, 2012 letter did not, as it states, include "copies of pertinent sections of the Access to Information Act and the Privacy Act".

Provided you correct my personal information, as requested above, I grant to the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation my consent to the disclosure of information on any remuneration I may have received from CBC since 2001. I also request that any such disclosure provide an indication of the purpose of any such remuneration, and I ask that the Corporation share with me a copy of any response to the requesting party which contains my personal information.
